

Hi Folks,

This email constitutes your 'Further Information' for next weekend – we hope everyone is as excited as we are about the track day!

Just a couple of last minute tidbits for you to think about:

Timeline for the Day:

9:15 - gates open at Bryant Park - please follow the parking marshals directions
9:30 - scrutiny bay opens
9:45 - drivers briefing
10:00 - track opens
12:30 – burnt offerings from the bbq available for all
4:00 – latest time for track close
4:30 – For those staying for the Christmas function, Santa arrives for kids (big and small) – **Action Required – Please tell us how many kids and what age are coming so we can arrange gifts**
5:30 - dinner served – roast chicken & salad buffet, courtesy of Michael's Golden Hen of Moe
8:30 – pack-up begins

What to bring?

- Please remember to bring appropriate clothing for the weather, and long sleeve gear if you are planning on passenger rides
- If you are bringing easyups or other shelter, please note you cannot put pegs into the bitumen – please bring cornerweights to hold them down
- With 90 people for dinner, there are not quite enough chairs for all at the venue – if you feel like bringing the comfy camping chair, feel free!

Is there any risk of the day being cancelled?

- The activities from 4pm will go ahead REGARDLESS of the weather. We look forward to seeing you there for the awards night
- Daytime activities will only be cancelled in the event of a total fireban day

What happens on the day?

- When you arrive on the day, it doesn't matter if you head for scrutiny or documentation first.
- You will need a colour sticker from scrutiny and a wrist band from documentation to have access to the track.
- This year, rather than have a long queue, you will be called by colour group – 10 cars at a time. This way, you can spend the day socialising without having to line up!
- Just look for the board by the start line to tell you what colour group is coming up next, and listen for the megaphone announcement.
- If you are sharing cars, don't stress you will get less track time – we have mechanisms to accommodate that.

Passenger notes

- You must sign a passenger indemnity form and obtain a wristband from Noodles at Event Doco before queuing up to ride
- You must be at least 14 years old
- You must have neck to wrist to ankle clothing, and a well-fitting helmet
- Maximum one passenger at a time

Reminder for all

- Food
 - The canteen won't be open on the day – we will supply basic BBQ food at lunchtime and will have limited softdrinks available – we recommend bringing some of your own supplies to keep you going through the day – especially water if it's hot!
 - BYO refreshments & glasses for the party – plates / cutlery supplied
- Track
 - No wristband, no start
 - Please don't join the line until your group is called
