SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1 AUTHORITY:** The Event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the National Motorkhana Code, 2015, the CAMS Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines and these Supplementary Regulations, and any Further Regulations issued by the Organisers. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au
- 2 EVENT.** The Event will be a multi club Motorkhana and Practice Day. Preference will be given to members of CCRMIT before other car clubs
- 3 PERMIT.** The Event will be held under CAMS Permit No. 315/1207/05 which will be on display at the venue.
- 4 ORGANISERS and PROMOTERS:** The Event will be organised and promoted by the Car Club of CCRMIT INC
- 5 OFFICIALS:**

- 6 VENUE:** The event will be held at Ladner Park
55 Burnt Store Rd, Lardner VIC 3821 (in the Lower Car Park Gate 1)
- 7 SCHEDULE:**
 - Documentation & Scrutiny:** 9.30 am – 3:30pm
 - Drivers Briefing:** 10:00am or after the scrutiny of the car during the day
 - The event is expected to conclude by 4:00pm.**
- 8 DRIVERS BRIEFING:** Drivers Briefings will be given for drivers, before beginning any driver can commence track activity, this briefing will commence at the completion of the cars scrutineering.
 - a. **All** vehicles will undergo a safety check by CAMS Scrutineers prior to participation with an emphasis on brakes and seatbelts. Cars must also be free of loose items
 - b. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions
 - c. There is to be no rally tires used on the grass surface road treads only.
 - d. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.
 - e. The Clerk of Course will have the final say on whether or not a vehicle is deemed eligible to participate.
 - f. All passengers, including those who have signed an entry form, must sign the appropriate Passenger in Vehicle Indemnity Form.
- 9 ENTRIES:** The entry fee for this event will be **\$30**. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual. Entries open on publication of these regulations and close after 3.30pm on the day of the event. The maximum number of entries for this event will be 40. Entries will be decided upon on order of receipt and eligibility. **NOTE:** Drivers need a minimum Level 2 licence - Non Speed (L2NS)

10 MOTORKHANA:

- a. This event will take place on a Grass surface.
- b. All drivers must hold a minimum of a Level 1 Come and Try Licence. All coaches will be the holders of a minimum L2NS Licence.
- c. All participants must wear apparel including helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual (Appropriate footwear, no thongs or high heels).
- d. There will be various training exercises conducted throughout the day.
- e. There will be timing recorded during the event but no official results will be issued other than the boards on the day

11 **BEHAVIOUR:** Individuals behaving in a manner deemed to be inappropriate or prejudicial to the sport by the Clerk of Course will be excluded from the event.

12 **ABANDONMENT:** The organiser reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

13 **INSURANCE:** Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual. Public Risk Insurance is covered by the Permit, and Personal Accident Insurance is incorporated into the Licence fee.

14 **PASSENGERS:** AS per the current National Motorkhana Code

19 A passenger may be carried in a vehicle while competing in a motorkhana as described in 19.1, except: (i) In the Australian Motorkhana Championship. (ii) Where prohibited in the Supplementary Regulations.

19.1 An inexperienced driver (either junior or an adult), may carry an experienced passenger, or an experienced driver may carry a junior or inexperienced adult passenger for the purpose of instruction and guidance in State, Multi-Club or Club level events under the following conditions: (i) A request is lodged with and approved by the Clerk of the Course. (ii) The suitability of the passenger or the experienced driver is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. (iii) Each passenger shall complete the CAMS "Passenger in Vehicle Disclaimer Form" before any test. (iv) Any driver carrying a passenger during competition is not eligible to score points in a State Motorkhana Championship event. (v) Only one passenger is permitted in the vehicle with the driver at any time during a test.

15 **PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES:** During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden within the Lardner Park site. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such.

In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will apply.

- a. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.
